### **If you want to join the National Audubon Society:**

Some people prefer a National Audubon Society membership, which includes a subscription to the Society's *Audubon* magazine. To become a National member, go to the Society's website at [www.audubon.org](http://www.audubon.org) and click on "Join." (Select Y54 for the PVAS code in the drop down menu, if you are asked when you fill out the form.) If you join National Audubon and reside in PVAS's four-county service area (Berkeley, Jefferson, and Morgan counties in West Virginia, and Washington County Maryland) you will automatically become a member of PVAS and have access to our events and a subscription to our bi-weekly "Heads Up" e-newsletter. However, almost all of your dues payments will go to the National Audubon Society; only a small percentage will go to PVAS (100% of any additional donation above the membership fee will go to PVAS.)
