- Please enter all weather information and detail your effort below. It is critical to the accuracy of the data submitted in the final report and is what makes CBC data so important for use in scientific research.
- Please document ALL SPECIES not found on the checklist on the back. Photographic evidence is always preferred, but a good description will suffice. It's best to watch the bird(s) as long as possible, committing to memory all aspects of plumage, shape, and size (i.e. bill size and shape, wing shape, color pattern, tail length, streaking extent, comparisons to more common species, etc.)
